

## IOWA ROCKETS WEBSITE PICTURE ALBUM

We'd love to have pictures from every team.

### Here's how to submit pictures

1. Prepare the picture on your computer \*
  - a. Crop the picture to show just the "main" thing.
  - b. Resize the picture (if possible) to about 500 pixels wide
  - c. Save the picture to a medium-high compression quality (the picture will end up at about 150 kilobytes in size)
2. Email the your pictures to Beth Koppes (parent of 15 Black player) at EKoppes2000 @ gmail.com

Make the picture an attachment to your email. Select the best 2 or 3 pictures. Others on your team may also submit picture...so we'll get a variety.

### Here are a couple guidelines.

- We WANT pictures, but not too many picture. Please select the good, fun pictures that others will enjoy. (Our space on the Rockets website is limited. If we host too many pictures it may take a long time for the picture page to display.)
- Please indicate the TEAM and TOURNAMENT and DATE
- Please provide a CAPTION (that's the toughest part for our website people to do), so please provide one. Also, avoid using player's names unless necessary.

Give it a couple days and they should be on the Rockets website!

\* Okay, if you don't know how to "crop", "resize" and change the compression, then just send your picture anyway. If you are able to Crop, Resize and Compress – this will make sending the picture much faster AND will be less work for our website people.

Want to learn how to Crop, Resize, and Edit your photographs? It's actually quite easy.

If you want to crop & further edit, you'll need different software. Resize your photo to 500 pixels wide. Always save a COPY of your photo – leave the original photo unchanged.
