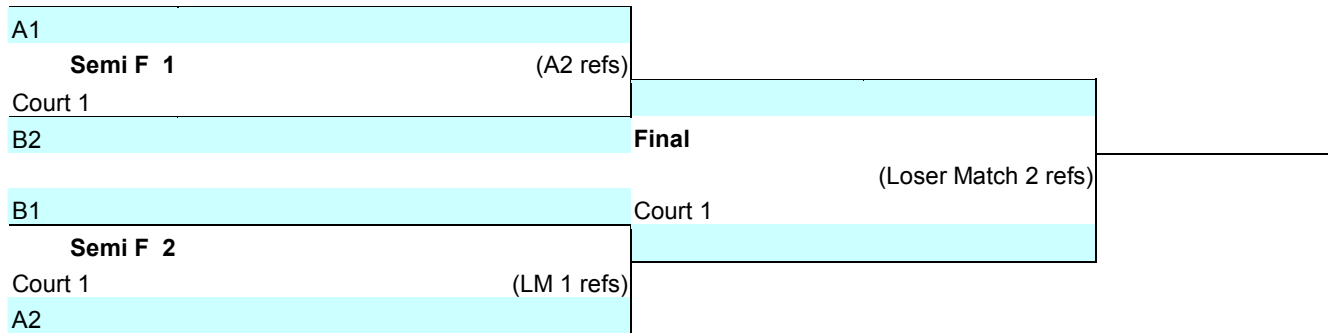

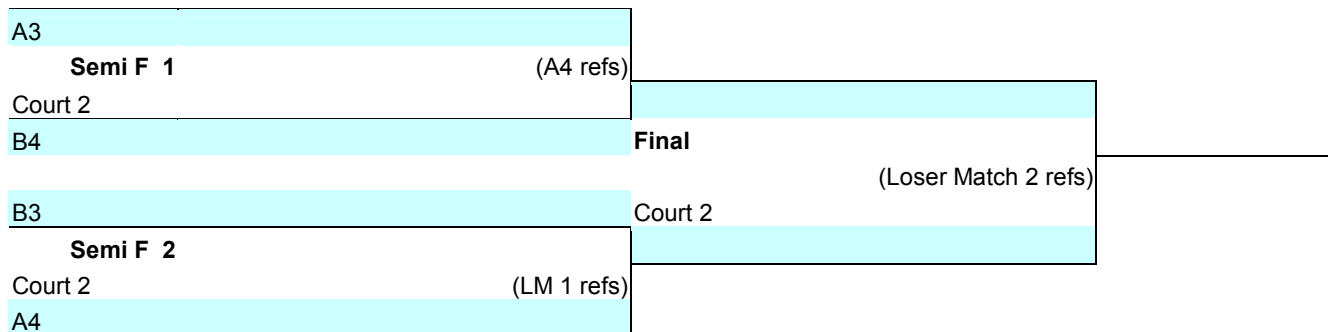

MARION MAGIC VBC TOURNAMENT

POOL PLAY: Play will consist of *two sets to 21* with no cap. Teams will have 10 minutes to warm up for their first match of the day. (4-4-2). Thereafter, each match will begin just 5 minutes (4-1) after the end of the previous match. The team listed first will be the SERVING team- the opposing team will decide side prior to warm up. Certified ADULT referees are required for all playoff matches, and highly preferred for pool play. If juniors are used for during pool play, coaches should stand next to or behind their player with a whistle to assisting in the officiating as needed. Thank you.

BRACKET PLAY: The first and second place teams for each pool will advance to the Championship Playoff. The third and fourth place teams for each pool will advance to the Consolation Playoff. The fifth place team will not advance. In case of a tie for second or fourth place...if head to head wins in pool play is split, teams will play a one game playoff to 15 points, no cap. All other ties will be determined by... head to head wins, point spread head to head, total pool play points, and as last resort a coin flip between tied teams.

Playoff matches will be best 2 out of 3, to 25. All third matches will be played to 15 points. Individual medals will be given to 1st in the championship bracket and to 1st place in the consolation bracket.

- 1.) Pool play will begin promptly at 8:15 teams may arrive no earlier than 7:30am. Each team should arrive at least 30 minutes early... as we will play ahead. Each team will be allowed a 10 minute warm up prior to their first match, precisely five minutes thereafter. Ball warm up is strictly limited to the gym!
- 2.) Please check in with the tournament director at the tournament table upon arrival to verify rosters. Please bring a current roster and marked volleyballs for warm ups.
- 3.) A **BOUNTIFUL CONCESSION** will be provided to all visitors. **NO OUTSIDE FOOD, COOLERS or POTLUCKS will NOT be permitted in the building, NO EXCEPTIONS! All food and drink are limited to the large cafeteria readily accessible from both gyms; only capped beverages are permitted in the gyms. Thank you for supporting our fundraiser!**
- 4.) Upon entering the building from the preferred North parking lot, you will walk into the commons area. (The overflow south parking lot entry also feeds into the same commons area.) The commons (cafeteria) separates two gyms. BOTH GYMS have plenty of BLEACHER SEATING.
- 5.) TEAM CAMPS are to be limited to the commons area and should be respectfully situated to allow for safe accessibility throughout the facility by all visitors. *All camp areas are expected to be clean and orderly upon each team's departure!* We appreciate your respect and common courtesy.
- 6.) Adult referees are REQUIRED during all Playoff matches and are preferred during pool play. If juniors are used during pool play, coaches must stand next to or behind their player at all times with a whistle ready to assist if needed. We appreciate your understanding and compliance.
- 7.) Upon your team's completion of their participation, we ask that you please check with the tournament director prior to leaving to finalize any responsibilities. All teams are required to stay after a loss and ref the proceeding match.

DIRECTIONS to MARION HIGH SCHOOL **75 S. 15th Street Marion, IA 52302**

Directions from I-380: Take the Blairs Ferry Rd. exit. Drive east on Blairs Ferry Rd. as far as the road will take you. At the t-intersection (Marion Blvd.), turn left. This road becomes 7th Ave. in Marion. Drive through downtown Marion past Walgreen's. **Turn (right) south on 15th St. (Denny's Muffler Center is on the corner.)** Drive to the 4-way stop, and continue through the intersection 3-4 more blocks on 15th Street. Marion High School will be on the left-hand (east) side. Preferred parking is on the north side of the building (first entrance), but there is overflow parking on the south side (second entrance).

Directions from Hwy 151: Enter Marion from the east on 151 (street name becomes 7th Ave.) and drive until you get to 15th St. (immediately after Denny's Muffler). Turn left (south). Drive to the 4-way stop, and continue through the intersection 3-4 more blocks on S. 15th Street. Marion High School will be on the left-hand (east) side. Preferred parking is on the north side of the building (first entrance), but there is overflow parking on the south side (second entrance).

Directions from Hwy 30: Turn off Hwy 30 at the Hwy 13 north exit and drive north on Hwy 13 until you get to the Hwy 100 stoplight. Turn left or west on Hwy 100 and drive until you get to your first stoplight at East Post Road. Turn right (north) into Marion. The road will narrow, then turn right at the first stoplight on Grand Avenue (Casey's Convenience Store on the corner). Drive 2-3 blocks to the stop sign (15th St). Turn left (north) on S. 15th and Marion High School will be two blocks ahead on your right. *Preferred parking past the school on the north side the second entrance).*
