

2010 MV Wildcat Attack 14U Volleyball Tournament

Pool play: Pool play will start at 8:00 AM sharp! 2 games to 21, win by 2, no cap.

All teams will have a ten minute warm up before their first match of the day. After the first match, each team will have 6 minutes of warm up (3-3) If you are reffing this match, please keep track of the time, keep it to 6 min so we can keep the tourney on schedule.

The tournament will play ahead once every team has played their first match. Be ready to play or ref when it's your teams turn.

Bring marked balls for warm ups and use them in the gym only - NO BALL HANDLING IN COMMONS AREA. Please provide team needs- whistles, pens, pencils, towels and medical supplies. Locker rooms are not available, but restrooms are.

I do ask that when your team is officiating, an adult official is to stand by the up ref. You are there as their coach to teach good officiating and to answer any questions they may have during a match, and to guide them. Adult up-refs only during bracket play.

The 1st and 2nd place teams will advance to the championship bracket. The 3rd and 4th place team will advance to the consolation bracket.

Play off seeding will be decided on overall game record. Tiebreakers will be in this order 1) win/loss record 2) head to head 3) point differential.

There will be a scheduled break for 20 minutes after the 9:40 match.

Bracket play:

BRACKET PLAY WILL BEGIN IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE FINISH OF POOL PLAY. The 6 min warm-up will be used.

Best of three to 25, third game to 15, switch @ 8, win by 2, no cap.

Trophies will be given to the first and second place teams from the championship bracket.

Concessions:

The Maquoketa Valley Booster Club will provide a full concession stand with drinks, pop corn, and snacks. We will have items like breakfast pizza, cinnamon rolls, pizza, yogurt, pretzels, walking tacos, hot dogs, and marinated chicken sandwiches, etc. The booster club asks that NO OUTSIDE COOLERS OR FOOD is brought into the facility.

In addition, please pick up your areas and help keep the gym areas clean by throwing garbage away in the gym area trash cans. Thanks for your cooperation in advance. Bleacher seating is available.
